

GUI

QJ-Pro does not include a Java runtime environment (JRE). You will need a 1.3 or 1.4 level Java runtime or Java development kit (JDK) installed on your machine in order to run QJ-Pro. This section contains the description on how to install and run the standalone client of QJ-Pro.

Windows

Download the latest binary release, called `qjpro_Vx_x_gui.zip`, and unzip it into any directory, for example `C:\QJ-ProVx_x`. To run QJ-Pro go to the directory `C:\QJ-Pro-Vx_x\bin` and run `xclient.exe` this will bring up the GUI. If you happen to see flashing DOS boxes while you are working with the tool you can also use `winclient.exe` to start the GUI, this command makes sure that the boxes do not appear.

Linux/Unix

Download the latest binary release, called `qjpro_Vx_x_gui.zip`, and unzip it into any directory, for example `/home/wally/QJ-ProVx_x`. To run QJ-Pro go to the directory `/home/wally/QJ-ProVx_x/bin` and run `xclient.linux` or `xclient.solaris`.
